This is a confirmation that V Group, Inc. DBA not applicable is eligible to continue in the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program (DBE) under the District of Columbia Unified Certification Program. Your firm is subject to the requirements of the DBE regulations, Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 26, as amended and all laws of this jurisdiction applicable to the transaction of business.

As a certified DBE, you are required to submit an annual "No Change/Notice Regarding Change" statement, attesting to your continued status as a "socially and economically disadvantaged individual" on the firm's anniversary date. You must also submit the Firm's most current Federal Tax Returns and the owner's personal net worth statement. The "No Change"/"Notice Regarding" Change Statement and supporting documentation should be uploaded into DDOT's Civil Rights Compliance System at <https://ddot.dbesystem.com>.

If a change in the ownership, control or management of your firm has occurred, you must complete and submit a "Notice Regarding Change" statement immediately after the change.

Your certification does not automatically expire, however; your firm must submit the required documents annually on or before your firm's certification date. Failure to provide the requested documents in a timely manner will result in immediate actions to decertify your firm's eligibility as a Disadvantaged Business Enterprise with the District of Columbia Unified Certification Program.
